

2017 Volcanic Hill

Diamond Creek Vineyards was founded on the philosophy that different soils impart distinct flavors in a wine. Planted in 1968 on light, fluffy, ashy soil, the Volcanic Hill Vineyard comprises approximately 8 acres of the total Diamond Creek estate.

The 2017 vintage year began with abundant rainfall, followed by a mild Spring resulting in extended flowering with little shatter. The wines of this vintage are often described as elegant with great complexity of flavor.

- Aged 22 months in French oak
- Blend: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot
- Strikingly complex and well-defined by its signature big bold tannins, the wine is filled with blackberries and plum, baking spices, mocha and espresso flavors that make this wine incredibly attractive in its youth but will age with grace and allure.
