



2019 Three Vineyard Blend

Since 1968, Diamond Creek Vineyards has celebrated the unique personalities of its distinct vineyard sites with individual bottlings. The Three Vineyard Blend began as an experiment to study the dichotomy between the single-vineyards and the blend. Over the years, we found that the assemblage has its own expression, worthy of special recognition.

The 2019 growing season offered us superb conditions with parallels in quality to the 2018 vintage with one exception - lower than expected yields. A mild, wet spring gave promise that extended into a long summer with steady ripening. Harvest patiently followed with long hang times and unhurried phenolic ripeness. Selective picks began on the estate in early October followed by careful sorting and focused winemaking.

The wines are remarkable expressions of the vintage, weaving together power and elegance, and purity of fruit.

- Harvested September 11th - October 27th, 2019
- Aged 30 months in French oak
- Blend: 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Malbec, 2% Petit Verdot
- Tasted August 2023 - Aromas reveal dark cherry, bramble fruit, cassis, cacao, and bergamot. The palate is cassis, red and black plums, black cherry, cedar, clove, Earl Grey tea, and graphite. The tannins are fine-grained and firm and the finish is lasting.
